CONSOLIDATED PLAN FOR THE GRAND JUNCTION COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM

RECITALS.

The City of Grand Junction was designated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) as an Entitlement Community in 1996. This designation entitles the City to receive annual funding through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. To remain eligible for CDBG funding, the City must prepare and submit an Annual Action Plan that is incorporated into the City's Consolidated Plan and serves as a federally required planning document guiding community development activities.

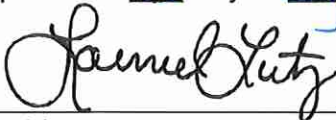
The purpose of the Consolidated Plan and the CDBG Program is to develop viable communities by providing decent housing, creating a suitable living environment, and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low- and moderate-income. The City's 2026–2030 Consolidated Plan established priority needs, goals, and strategies through coordination with community stakeholders, nonprofit organizations, government agencies, and residents.

Development of the 2026 Program Year Annual Action Plan included citizen participation and interagency involvement and identifies the activities and investments to be undertaken during the 2026 program year in furtherance of the goals and priorities established in the 2026–2030 Consolidated Plan. The Annual Action Plan implements the strategic direction established by the Consolidated Plan and supports the community development objectives identified through the planning process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

The Recitals are incorporated herein. The City Council adopts the 2026 Program Year Annual Action Plan as a part of the City of Grand Junction's 2026-2030 five-year consolidated plan for the Grand Junction CDBG program.
