MEMORANDUM AGREEMENT

This Memorandum Agreement, entered into this 21st day of January, 1966, by and between the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, the Grand Valley Irrigation Co., and the Grand Junction Drainage District,

WITNESSETH:

That Whereas, the parties hereto have heretofore, through joint cooperative effort, relocated the portion of the Mesa County Canal which formerly ran from 28 3/4 Road through the Teller Arms Shopping Center east through the Municipal golf course and south on 19th Street in the City, all north of the D & R G W railroad tracks, and

Whereas, it has been determined that the portion 28-3/4 Road, except that portion Quit Claimed to Wallace Corn, of such Canal located between 26 Road and ~~28 Road~~ should not be abandoned but is required for drainage use,

Now, Therefore, It is Mutually Agreed:

1. That the Grand Junction Drainage District will assume the maintenance and supervision of that portion of the old Mesa County Canal between 28 Road and ~~28 1/2 Road~~ 28-3/4 Road, except that portion Quit Claimed to Wallace Corn, to provide necessary drainage for the area involved.

Grand Valley Irrigation Co. agrees that all of its rights in and to such portion of the Canal may be exercised by the Drainage District, relieving the company from any obligation therein; and, it further agrees to execute such documents, if any, as may be required by the Drainage District to accomplish such transfer of control and maintenance.
