## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

The County is the owner of the land situate in Mesa County and described as follows:

The Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 1 South, Range 1 East, Ute Meridian, EXCEPT Beginning at the Southeast Corner of said Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, thence West 580 feet, thence North 560 feet, thence North 68° East 479 feet, thence South 77° East 100 feet, thence South to Beginning.

The City and the County are desirous of constructing and operating a joint recreational project to provide a boat ramp on the County property.

## IT IS THEREFORE AGREED:

- 1. That the City, through its Parks and Recreation Department, shall prepare specifications and contract for the construction of a concrete boat ramp and gravel parking lot on the above-described land.
- 2. The City will conduct the bidding and will handle the site inspections for the construction, make final approval of the project and make the payments to the contractor out of \$10,000 comprised of Centennial-Bicentennial monies and City monies.
- 3. Upon completion of the project, it will be the responsibility of the County to operate and maintain the facility as may be necessary.
- 4. Each of the parties will hold the other harmless from any costs or damages arising out of its specific obligations hereunder.
