AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this <u>19th</u> day of <u>June</u> A. D., 1956, by and between THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OF COLORADO, a body corporate, acting for the use and benefit of THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS hereinafter called the "Department", and where the term "Department" is used hereafter it may be construed to include the Department's contractor, and THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO, and where the term "City" is used it may be construed to include the City's contractor, hereinafter called the "City",

WITNESSETH, That

WHEREAS, Department's plans and specifications for the construction of Project No. F 001-1(12) through the City of Grand Junction require the installation of certain lighting equipment on certain portions of the project, and

WHEREAS, the parties have previously determined to what extent each party shall participate in the procurement and installation of said lighting equipment, and

WHEREAS, it has been previously determined by the parties that maintenance and operation of this lighting equipment, after installation, shall be the responsibility of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and agreements hereinafter contained and the faithful performance thereof, the parties hereto agree as follows:

> The Department agrees to furnish, at its expense and according to Department plans and specifications for the above numbered project and as approved by the U. S. Bureau of Public Roads, the necessary light standards and luminaires, as part of the project cost.

- The City will install, or have installed, at its own expense concrete bases, the light standards, the wiring, the conduits and the luminaires.
- 3. The above lighting equipment will be installed at points along said project to be determined jointly by the City and the Department, following as nearly as possible the original designations as shown on the final project plans and specifications.
- 4. The City agrees to furnish all electricity and power for said lighting equipment after the units are placed in operations and project is completed and opened to the traveling public.
- 5. The City agrees to operate and maintain the lighting equipment after the completion of the project, without interfering with the normal traffic operations on the readways.
- 6. All power and electricity furnished by the City and all maintenance operations shall be at the sole expense of the City. The term "maintenance" shall be construed to include replacement of the lighting units or any portions thereof at any time hereafter.

THIS AGREEMENT shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
