NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT JOINTLY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MESA, COLORADO, AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

That the Fiscal Years 1994-1998 Transportation Improvement Program/Annual Element for the Grand Junction/Mesa County Urbanized Area, hereunto attached, was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Mesa, Colorado, on August 10, 1993, and by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, on August 18, 1993.
