## RESOLUTION NO. 45-95

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN TWO CONTRACTS WITH GREAT OUTDOORS COLORADO (GOCO) FOR THE BLUE HERON, PHASE II TRAIL, AND COLUMBINE PARK PAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AND SAFETY SURFACE INSTALLATION

## Recitals.

The City of Grand Junction applied for and was awarded two Great Outdoors Colorado ("GOCO") grants: \$50,000 for the construction of Blue Heron Phase II Trail and \$35,000 for the installation of the City's Columbine Park playground equipment and safety surface.

City Council has, by adoption of the 1995 budget, previously approved the receipt of the \$50,000 for the trail construction.

The \$35,000 grant has not yet been approved by Council as a part of the budget or appropriation process; Parks staff recommends that said sum be aggregated with \$26,000 (which has been budgeted for) to replace the Columbine Park playground equipment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

The City Manager is authorized to execute the contracts to complete the grant acceptance process and to receive the funds.
