MINUTES

Grand Junction Commission on Arts and Culture (GJCAC) Wednesday, February 26, 2014, Hospitality Suite, Lincoln Park

Chair Lancer Livermont called the meeting to order at 4:05 p.m. Lancer said the minutes of the last meeting indicated that Eli Marco of Colorado Mesa University offered every Commissioner a CO2 show poster in the color of their choice. Lorie Gregor circulated a sheet for all Commissioners, who selected from the two color schemes. Randall Cupp moved to approve the minutes of the Jan. 22 meeting without change. Darcy Johnson seconded the motion, and the minutes were approved unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

1% for the Arts: Rob Schoeber, Parks and Recreation Director, said that the city's 1% for the Arts fund has approximately \$100,000 left over from prior construction projects. Of that amount, about \$20,000 is committed to finishing current projects with plaques etc. After discussion Miranda Ashman moved to approve giving City Council \$80,000 for the Avalon Theatre remodel. Jeremy Franklin seconded and the motion passed unanimously. The \$80,000 is contingent on approval by Council of the full build out of the Avalon. Councilman Bennett Boeschenstein thanked the Commissioners for their support and invited them to the next City Council meeting, where the Avalon project would be discussed.

Departures: The Commissioners thanked Randall Cupp and Charity Finnigsmier for their service on GJCAC, which would be completed with this meeting. Lorie presented as gifts to Randall and Charity clocks handcrafted by artist Connie Smith.
