Jim Robb announced that the most recent Riverfront Newsletter had been completed by Rick Boucher and was in the mail.

The Commission members were each given a copy of the latest issue of "Land and People" put out by the Trust For Public Lands. The cover features a photograph of the recently acquired Jarvis salvage yard, with Ward and Barbara Scott paddling by in their canoe. There is also an article about the acquisition.

Rebecca Frank announced a conference on land conservancies to be held March 16th in the Mesa County Hearing Room.

Bill Ela reported on a meeting with the Museum's Advisory Committee last Thursday. Bill, Jim Robb, Kathy Portner and Bennett Boeschstein attended and provided an update on the Riverfront Project. The members seemed interested in a possible Riverfront location for the new museum. The museum is also working on a 25 year anniversary celebration, which may involve the Riverfront.

The tailings pile removal has begun. The first train left the old Climax site on March 11th to the Cotter site south of Whitewater, where the tailings were unloaded onto trucks to continue on to the Cheney disposal site.
