"Be it enacted by the qualified electors of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, that Section 48 of Article VI of the Chatter of said city be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"48. Contractual Powers and Sale of Real Property .-- The Council shall have no power to make any contract of any kind or nature whatsoever, or to make any lease of city property except as hereinafter provided, the existence or term of which will extend beyond the time of the installation of the new Council elected at any subsequent general municipal election; but the Council shall have the following powers: (a) to sell and dispose of water works, ditches, gas works, electric light works, or other public utilities, public buildings, real property used or held for park purposes or any other real estate used or held for any governmental purposes, providing, however, that before any sale thereof shall be made the question of such sale and the terms and consideration thereof shall be submitted to and ratified by a majority vote of the qualified electors of the city who shall have paid a property tax therein during the preceding calendar year. and the vote thereon shall be by ballot deposited in a separate ballot box at a regular municipal election or at a special election called and held in the manner provided for by law; and (b) by ordinance or resolution to sell and dispose of and to lease any other real estate owned by the municipality, upon such terms and conditions as such City Council may determine at a regular or special meeting; and deeds of conveyance . .
