PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A GENERAL MUNICIPAL
ELECTION WILL BE HELD ON TUESDAY, THE 2nd DAY OF APRIL, A. D.
1929, AT THE POLLING PLACES HEREINAFTER DESIGNATED IN THE CITY
OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO.

That pursuant to Ordinance No. 447 of the City of Grand
Junction, adopted and approved the 6th day of March, A. D. 1929,
there will be submitted at said election to the vote of the
qualified tax-paying electors of the City of Grand Junction, the
following question:

QUESTION SUBMITTED

Shall the City Council of the City of Grand Junction
contract an indebtedness on behalf of the City and
upon the credit thereof, by issuing the negotiable
coupon bonds of the city in the aggregate amount of
forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) for the purpose of
paying the cost of paving street and alley intersec-
tions in said city?

The said general municipal election will be held at the
several polling places in the several districts and voting
precincts of the City of Grand Junction, in the State aforesaid,

Upon the date and at the places designated aforesaid, the polls will be open from the hour of 7 o'clock A. M. to and including and will be closed at the hour of 7 o'clock P. M. The ballots to be used in voting upon the questions above submitted will be prepared and furnished by the City Clerk to the Judges of the election, to be by them furnished to the voters. The election will be held and conducted, as nearly as may be, in the manner prescribed by law in the case of elections for municipal officers. Registration for the said election will take place in the manner now provided by law. At said election only duly qualified tax paying electors of the City shall be permitted to **vote** upon the question submitted.

That at said election a member of the City Council will be elected from each of three election districts of said City - namely: First Ward, East Third Ward, and Fourth Ward, and one member of the City Council will be elected from the City of Grand Junction at large, each of the said Councilmen to be elected for the regular four-year term.
