

Grand Junction Colo March 5<sup>th</sup> 1888

Board met at 7:30 with the following members present at  
Roll Call, S. P. Scovill, H. H. Rea, J. P. Cumeden, A. F. Paff,  
J. H. Hadcock, J. W. Bridges, and J. P. Sweeney Mayor.

Minutes previous meeting read and on motion approved,  
Reports of the Police Magistrate and City Treasurer for month  
of February, were presented, read and on motion accepted and  
ordered placed on file.

On motion Matt Farrell was given permission to erect a  
frame building in rear of his store on Main St.

On motion City Attorney was instructed to draw up an  
ordinance fixing the License for theatrical troupes at \$50 per  
year.

On motion the City Jail was made the place of voting  
at the Election on April the 3<sup>rd</sup> and the Recorder instructed to  
issue a call for the Annual City Election

A motion was then made and carried instructing the  
Recorder to buy a legal ballot box for the use of the City and  
to procure the necessary poll books, <sup>of Hamway, who was appointed judges of election.</sup> On motion L. A. Staley, W. B. Lawrence and

A proposition concerning electric lights for the town  
was then presented by Mr McFarland and after  
considerable discussion was on motion postponed  
until Thursday night March the 8<sup>th</sup>.

On motion a committee of three, consisting of A. F. Paff,  
J. W. Bridges and H. H. Rea were appointed to confer with  
Mr McFarland in regard to the electric light proposition.

On motion Frank Anthony was continued as Night  
Watchman during the month of March, the City to  
pay him \$35 per month.

The question of Annual Appropriation was referred to the  
Finance Committee.

On motion the following bills were allowed  
and the Clerk instructed to draw warrants  
for the several amounts.
