

Grand Junction Feb 16 - 1888.

Special Meeting called for contracting for water for the season of 1888, Marshal reported having notified every member of the Board.

Present at Roll Call - J. J. Lumsden & H. Hadcock S. J. Scovill. J. W. Bridges A. F. Paff and Mr Mayor.

On motion the following proposition from Gov Crawford was put upon its passage and adopted by the following affirmative vote.

S. J. Scovill yes. J. W. Bridges yes. A. F. Paff yes. H. Hadcock yes. J. J. Lumsden yes.

Grand Junction Colo Feb 16 - 1888

To the Mayor and Council of Grand Junction Colo - Gentlemen
We propose to furnish the town of Grand Junction 100 inches of water for \$400⁰⁰ in warrants for the season of 1888
The water to be received by the town at our headgate in the Pioneer Extension Ditch, same as last season, when there is sufficient water in said ditch, or to be received at the headgate of G & A Crawfords lateral at the Grand River Ditch, when there is not sufficient water in the Pioneer Extension. Payment of \$400⁰⁰ in warrants to be made by you at the close of the season. The Mayor to determine the close of the season, unless the Grand River Ditch Co or Mesa Co & Pioneer Ditch Cos from whose ditches the water shall be taken shall shut off the water sooner. The only penalty to which we are willing to submit will be a proportionate reduction of the amount, corresponding to the number of days of failure of supply, as compared with the whole number of days of supply valued at \$400

The town to take the water at the ditch or ditches as above stated.

The Pacific Slope Ditch Co by G. A. Crawford President,
I consent to the free use of my laterals
Geo A Crawford.

I further consent to the use by the town under this
Contract, of my privileges in the Grand Rivern. Mesa Co
and Pioneer Extension Ditches under my contracts
with the companies owning those ditches
Geo A Crawford.

Board then adjourned to next regular meeting.
