

Grand Junction Colo. April 11th 1888.

Board of Trustees met pursuant to adjournment at 7:30 P.M. and was called to order by A. G. Paff Mayor Pro-Tem. (The Mayor being absent). There were present at roll call Trustees Bridges, Haddock, Lumsden and Paff - absent Trustees Rosa and Seville & Mayor Survey.
