

Grand Junction, Colo. April 4th 1888

Board of Trustees met pursuant to adjournment at 7:30 P.M. with the Mayor J.P. Sweeney in the chair. Then were present at roll call Trustees Bridges, Hadcock, Paff and Lunnell and Mayor J.P. Sweeney. Absent Trustees Rea and Seville. The minutes of the meetings of March 8th, March 12th and April 2nd were then read and approved. Report of Town Treasurer for month of March 1888, was then read and ordered filed. Report of Town Treasurer for the fiscal year ending March 31st 1888, was then read, and ordered published in the Grand Junction News. Reports of Police Magistrate for the past fiscal year, and for the month of March 1888, were read and ordered filed. The finance committee reported progress in their investigations as to cost & advisability of building vault or procuring safe, and committee instructed to continue their investigations & report as soon as convenient. Two petitions of certain electors of the town relative to the calling of a special waterworks election were then read and on motion the further consideration thereof was deferred until next meeting.
