May 12 - 1857

Board met at 7.30 o'clock.

Present at roll call, T.H. Hadcock, J.W. Bridges, J.J. Lumsden, H.H. Rea
and J.P. Sweeney, Mayor.

Minutes previous meeting read and approved,
Petition of O.B. Miller presented and referred to the Committee on
License. Committee reported in favor of the petition and on
motion it was put on its passage with the following result
T.H. Hadcock ^{voting no} J.W. Bridges J.J. Lumsden, H.H. Rea and J.P. Sweeney

voting yes,

On motion the city marshal was instructed to collect the sum of
seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) from all traveling troupes &
theaters ^{for} ~~in~~ this city.

Bill of Rice Bros ^{for \$34.74} allowed and Recorder ordered to draw a warrant
for the same.

Bill of Alexander allowed and warrant ordered drawn,
Bids of Rice Bros & Kent & Campbell ~~was~~ for furnishing city
lumber had, and on motion that of Rice Bros accepted
Lumber to be furnished for the next three months from date
at \$25.00 per thousand in City Warrants.

On motion City Marshal was instructed not to box the
ditch in front of Dr Mahaffies lot, unless some one objected,
Regarding the matter of boxing ditches in front of
Poffes Stable the same on motion was laid over until
next meeting.

On motion the Marshal was instructed to ask for bids
for building the boxes on main Street and said bids
to be referred to the Mayor to receive or reject as the case
might be.

Bill of Denver Republican for furnishing Town Seal
allowed and warrant ordered drawn.

On motion adjourned until time of next
regular meeting.
