in the Town of Grand Junction, Mesa County Colo. the said amount of \$5. ⁹¹/₁₀₀ being the cost of constructing boxes or flumes in the ditches in front of each said lots and said work having been done in compliance with the ordinance in such cases made & provided, On motion the Marshal was instructed to enforce the Ordinance concerning gambling
