

Grand Junction Iowa January 29th 1887

Board met pursuant to a call ^{at 7:30 P.M.} made by the mayor for special meeting. The following members ^{and} officers were present at Roll call.

Edwin Price, J. T. Sharp, S. S. Dickie, John Hynes, W. T. Carpenter, Trustees. James W. Buckner Mayor, L. A. Seavey Atty.

W. T. Carpenter was chosen Recorder Pro Tem.

The Mayor then stated the object of the meeting, was for the purpose of taking such steps as may be necessary to rid the town of gamblers ^{and} thereby prevent such soberies as accrued this day. A motion was made by Councilman Price ^{seconded} and carried, that the City Atty be instructed to draw an Ordinance to prohibit gambling ^{and} keeping houses for that purpose ^{and} that the same be ready for passage on Tuesday evening Feb: 1st 1887.

The Board then adjourned to meet Tuesday evening Feb: 1st 1887 at 7³⁰ o'clock P.M.
