

Grand Junction Colo. January 14th 1887

Board met pursuant to a call made by the Mayor for Special Meeting. The following members & officers were present at Roll Call.

W. J. Carpenter. John Myers. J. T. Sharp Trustees.
James W. Bucklin Mayor. W. J. Quinn Recorder.

The Mayor stated the object of the meeting was to confer with W. S. Jackson President of the D^{and} R. G. Ry. in regard to moving the stock yards on fifth street, ^{and} to consider bill of J. A. Layton for extending Tax list for 1886.

A Motion was made seconded ^{and} carried instructing Mayor Bucklin to correspond with W. S. Jackson in regard to moving stock yards on fifth street.

A Motion was made seconded ^{and} carried to tent bill of J. A. Layton for extending Tax list for 1886 for \$1500⁰⁰/₁₀₀ to \$75⁰⁰/₁₀₀. ^{and} Recorder instructed to draw warrant on the City Treasurer for same.
