a lot in Block 102 was read and on motion granted.

approved.

read and on motion accepted.

On motion the City Attorney was instructed to take an appeal in the case of Douglass vs Town of Grand Junction decided in the County Court this day against said town. It was moved and seconded that the Contract with the Pacific Slope Ditch Company for the delivery of water for the season of 1886 be renewed for the period one one year with the following changes 1st the words "for and during the season of 1886" where the same occur on the first page of said Contract shall be changed so as to read as follows, "for and during the season of 1887" Second- The first payment of Two hundred dollars therein provided for shall be made at the first meeting of the Board of Trustees of said Town in the month of April 1887, instead of upon the execution thereof. and that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Contract on the part of the town

The ayes and nays being called with the following result.

John Haynes yes J. F. Sharp yes N. J. Carpenter yes James W. Brewster, Mayor yes. and the motion was declared duly carried.

On motion the Clerk was instructed to draw warrants on the Treasurer to the amount of \$200.⁰⁰ in favor of the Pacific Slope Ditch Co. being balance due on Contract for water for the season of 1886.
