

Grand Junction Colorado May 10th 1886

Board met pursuant to adjournment

The following were present at Roll call

N. S. Carpenter, John Hynes, J. I. Sharp, Edwin Price Trustees James W. Bucklin Mayor L. A. Staley City Attorney Geo. M. Huskine Recorder

According to previous instructions by the Board, the City Attorney presented to the Board Contract with the Pacific Slope Ditch Company for water, which upon motion was approved.

Moved and seconded that the clerk draw warrant in favor of the Pacific Slope Ditch Co for \$200⁰⁰ on it filing a bond for faithful performance in fulfilling the water Contract with the Town of Grand Junction for the year 1886. approved by the Mayor.

The following members voted for the motion and it was declared Carried

N. S. Carpenter, John Hynes, J. I. Sharp, Edwin Price Trustees and J. W. Bucklin Mayor

Moved and seconded that the following resolution be adopted and entered of Record, Be it Resolved and ordered by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction as follows:

There shall be submitted at a special election to be held on the 1st day of June A.D. 1886, at the Council room in the Town Jail in the Town of Grand Junction, Mesa County Colorado, to the vote of the qualified electors of said Town for their approval or disapproval, the proposition to sink an Artesian well and provide water works for said town, and to expend in said work a sum not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).

That the Mayor and Recorder prepare and sign and cause to be published and posted at least fifteen days before said election, a notice and call for said election to be held June 1st, 1886.

That all persons voting on said question or proposition shall vote by ballot, whereon shall be written or printed the words "For Artesian Well and Water Works", or the words "Against Artesian Well and Water Works".

And that said vote be canvassed in the same manner as the vote for town officers at a regular town election.

The following members voted for the Resolution and it was declared Carried,

John Hynes, J. I. Sharp, N. S. Carpenter, Edwin Price Trustees and J. W. Bucklin Mayor

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Moved seconded and Carried that the Clerk be instructed to notify W. W. Smith that upon his giving Warranty Deed to the Town of Grand Junction for land of his used in the extending of 5th Street the Clerk will deliver to said Smith Warrant on the Town Treasurer for \$100⁰⁰

The following members voted for the motion

John Hynes, Edwin Price, H. J. Carpenter, J. T. Sharp Trustee and J. W. Bucklin Mayor

On motion the City Attorney was instructed to prepare and present at next regular meeting of the Board an Ordinance compelling property owners of the Town place boxes in front of there property to run the ditches through.

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS.

MAY 10, 1886.—Full board in attendance.

Contract with Geo. A. Crawford for water was approved. Clerk ordered to draw warrants for \$200 to the Pacific Slope Ditch Company, on filing of proper bond.

Resolution elsewhere printed concerning special election was passed.

Clerk was instructed to notify N. N. Smith that the board will pay him \$100 for right of way across his property at the foot of Fifth street, upon execution of deed to the city.

City attorney was instructed to prepare ordinance to submit at next meeting, requiring property owners to box the ditches in front of their property.
