Board met at 8 o'clock P. M.

Present at Roll call

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Petition of Murray and Ryan for liquor license was read and on motion it was refused on account of not being in proper shape

The following bills were allowed and Clerk instructed to draw warrants on Treasurer for same

On motion the Clerk was instructed to draw warrants for salaried officers.

The Board then on motion proceeded to ballot for Deputy City Marshall.

J. J. Sharp, D. S. Dickie, W. J. Carpenter, Edwin Price, John Heynes, Trustees J. W. Bucklin, Mayor. Six votes were cast, B. K. Kennedy received six votes and was declared duly appointed Deputy City Marshall.

J. B. Clayton appeared before the Board and after some discussion in regard to water works the following Committee was appointed to act with Mr. Clayton in preparing a schedule of prices for water J. W. Bucklin, Mayor J. J. Sharp, John Heynes and W. J. Carpenter Trustees Board adjourned to meet October 7th 1886, at 10 o'clock A. M.
