Minutes of proceeding meeting read and approved.

Petition of C. B. Hays asking for leave of absence was read and was upon motion granted.

Resignation of N. A. Marsh as City Treasurer was read and on motion was laid on the table.

Report of City Treasurer for month of August was read and on motion approved.

On motion the following resolution was adopted by the Board.

Be it Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction Colorado, that for the purpose of defraying the expenses and liabilities of the Town of Grand Junction for the Fiscal year Commencing April 1st 1886, there be levied and collected on all taxable property real and personal within the limits of said Town of Grand Junction the following taxes on each dollar of valuation of such taxable property; to wit The sum of fifteen Mills.

Resolved that the Town Recorder be instructed to forthwith furnish to the Clerk and Recorder of Mesa County Colorado a Certified Copy of this resolution and levy.

On motion N. S. Jackson was allowed to take out license for transfer wagon for present quarter Commencing Sept 1st.

On motion the following resolution was adopted.

Be it Resolved that it is the sense of this Board that \$2000⁰⁰ would be a reasonable Compensation for the proposed water company (represented by Mr S. C. Clayton) for furnishing the Town with water, for fire and other public purposes, provided not less than ten fire plugs are furnished, and satisfactory terms can be agreed upon as to rates for supply for private purposes and other details, and in accordance with the terms of the proposition heretofore submitted to the Board by Mr Clayton.

On motion Clerk was instructed to draw warrants for the Salaries of officers for month of August.
