

Grand Junction September 8th 1886 Colorado

Special Meeting

Board met pursuant to call made by the Mayor for Special Meeting for taking some action in regard to placing gravel on part of Main Street.

Present at Roll call

H. J. Carpenter, John Hynek, Edwin Price, J. V. Sharp, Trustee, J. N. Buckner, Mayor, C. A. Staley, Attorney

Geo. W. Henshaw, Recorder being absent Edwin Price was on motion elected Recorder pro tem.

Board proceeded to open bids received from Geo. Smith and Hynek and award for placing gravel on main street.

The bid of Geo. Smith being lowest, the contract on motion of Mrs Hynek was awarded to Mrs Smith at \$1¹⁰ per yard, the gravel to be screened through a screen with meshes one inch square, said gravel to be placed on main street between 4th and 5th streets. It was also decided that not less than 50 or more than 75 yards should be contracted for at present.

On motion it was ordered that the contract be finished by September 25th 1886.
