

Grand Junction Colo Aug 1st 1867

Board met pursuant to adjournment with the following members present, to wit. S. J. Scovill, Thos Kadeock, H. K. Rea, J. J. Lumsden and J. P. Sweeney, Mayor.

Minutes previous meeting read and on motion approved, Report of the Police Magistrate read and on motion accepted. Report of City Treasurer, Read, considered and on motion accepted.

The following bills, were then read, considered and on motion recorder instructed to draw warrants for the several amounts, on the Treasurer,

On motion the citys oak crop now growing in Cottonwood Park was sold to A. J. Karlshorn for the sum of \$800 he to harvest the same at his own expense.

Committee on Streets, Alleys and Bridges were by motion instructed to examine the side walks on each of the street between third & fourth streets and ascertain the number of lots in front of which sidewalks were needed &c.

On motion the recorder was instructed to draw warrants on the Treasurer for the several amounts due officers for the month of July, to wit:
