

Grand Junction Colo. Aug 11th 87

Board met pursuant to adjournment,
Present at roll call, H. K. Pea, J. J. Lumsden
Thos. Hadcock, J. W. Bridges and J. P. Sweeney, Mayor,
Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion approved.
A petition from the Citizens of Grand Junction, asking
that a special election be called was read and
accepted, whereupon the following resolution was then
introduced and on motion placed upon its passage,
Be it resolved that there shall be submitted to the qualified
votes of the town of Grand Junction, Colo., at a special election
to be held at the Council Room in the town of Grand Junction
Mead County, Colo on the 6th day of Sept A.D. 1887 for the approval
or disapproval. The proposition for the Board of Trustees
of said town, to erect and construct, Holly Water works or
other similar system. The ballots to be cast at said
election shall contain the words "For Water Works or
Against Water Works" and resolved that the Recorder
be instructed to at once publish and post a notice and
call for said election. The yeas and nays were then

On motion the Recorder was instructed to publish Special Election Notice in both of the town papers. The following Resolution was introduced and an motion placed on its passage,

Whereas it is necessary in the opinion of this Board to have sidewalks constructed on Main Street in front of the following described lots and parcels of ground to wit: Lots, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 in block 119 and lots 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 in block 102, therefore be it resolved and ordered that sidewalks be constructed in front of said lots above described lots in accordance with and under the provisions of an ordinance entitled An Ordinance concerning the construction and repair of side walks, passed by the Board of Trustees the 12th day of July 1887,

On motion, Thurston and Smith were granted permission to erect a frame building in front of their store on lot 26 block 103.
