Special Meeting-

Meeting called to order at 8 o'clock P.M. with the following members present at roll call, S. J. Scoville J. W. Bridges, Thos Hadcock, H. H. Rea, J. J. Lumsden and J. P. Sweeney Mayor, The City Marshal Reported that he had notified all members that were in town that there would be a special meeting, this evening. The Mayor then stated the object of the meeting to be the reconsidering of the Resolution calling a Special Election for Water Works, On motion said resolution was reconsidered and revoked after being introduced and placed upon its passage. Thereupon the following resolution was introduced and placed upon its passage.

Be it resolved that there shall be submitted to the qualified electors voters of the town of Grand Junction, Colo at a Special election to be held at the Council Room in the town of Grand Junction, Mesa County Colo on the 13th day of Sept A. D. 1887 for their approval or disapproval the proposition for the Board

of Trustees of said town, to erect and construct
 a suitable system of water works for said town
 The ballots to be cast at said election shall contain
 the words For Water Works or Against Water Works
 and resolved that the Recorder be instructed to at
 once publish and post a notice and call
 for said election, The yeas and nays being
 called with the following result, H H Rea yes
 S. J. Scovill yes. Thos Hadcock yes. J. J. Lumsden yes
 J. W. Bridges yes.

On motion the following Judges of Election
 were chosen, J. A. Staley, A. P. Cook, and
 Q. Kennedy. On motion the following
 committee was appointed to investigate
 the proposition to bring water from Whitewater
 S. J. Scovill, J. W. Bridges and H H Rea,
