

Grand Junction Dec 15th 1887

Special Meeting for the purpose of approving of Crawford's addition to the town of Grand Junction, Marshall reported each member notified Board met with A. F. Paff mayor pro tem presiding

The following members were present at roll call S. J. Scovill, J. Lumsden H. H. Rea, A. F. Paff A. platt of Crawford's addition to the town of Grand Junction being presented to the board of trustees together with a petition signed by Geo A Crawford and David Roberts, the owners of more than two thirds of the area embraced in said addition. asking the approval of said platt. It was moved and seconded that whereas said platt is prepared in compliance with the law, and that all the necessary preliminary steps have been taken therefore the said platt be and is hereby approved and the Town Recorder be instructed to file the same in his office.

The motion being put to the Board the yeas and nays were called with the following result, S. J. Scovill yes J. Lumsden yes, H. H. Rea, A. F. Paff, yes, Thos Hadcock yes

The petition of Mishwitz and Reutter to open a retail liquor business in the Rio Grande Hotel was read and on motion put upon its passage, the yeas and nays being called with the following result, J. Scovill yes, J. Lumsden yes, H. H. Rea yes A. F. Paff yes, Thos Hadcock yes. whereupon said petition was granted and the Recorder instructed to issue a license,

On motion Frank Anthony's Bill for services as assistant Marshall during the fair was allowed at the rate of \$75 per month and a warrant ordered drawn. On motion J. Lumsden, H. H. Rea and Thos Hadcock were appointed a committee to investigate the Randall building. Adjourned to regular meeting. A. J. Kennedy Recorder.
