Petition of H. Hoersch for permission to erect a frame Ice House on
Lot 43 Block 103 was read^{2nd} on Motion granted.

Report of W.A. Marsh, Treasurer for Month December 1886 was read^{2nd}
on Motion approved.

City Engineer's Plans #1^{2nd} #2 for City Park was examined^{2nd} on
Motion plan #1 ~~approved~~ adapted.

On Motion Bill of Hynes^{2nd} and Orrer for team work on streets was
Reduced from \$6.00 per day to \$5.00 per day. ^{2nd} bill of A. Rigelow for
Labor on streets was reduced from \$2.50 per day to \$2.25 per day.

It was then moved seconded^{2nd} and carried that board do not pay
more than \$5.00 per day for team work nor more than \$2.25 per day
for labor.
