

Grand Junction April 16<sup>th</sup> 1888

Board of Trustees met pursuant to adjournment.

The minutes of the meetings of April 11th and 12th were read and approved. The following were present at Roll call The Mayor, and Trustees Hadcock, Scoville, Roberts, Lumsden, Hynes. Absent Rea.

On motion the Recorder was instructed to cast the ballot for J. J. Lumsden for Mayor pro-tem. Two communications were read & filed.

On motion the request of the Mayor and attorney made to F. B. Goudy Receiver of Grand River Dilch Co for <sup>water</sup> was approved.

On motion the Board went into executive <sup>session</sup> for the election of officers. Motion made and carried that the Board proceed to elect Marshal. Result was 5 votes for W. A. Hynoch. Trustees voting for Lumsden Hadcock, Scoville, Roberts, Hynes.

The Board then balloted for City Treasurer. W. J. Quinn received five votes. Trustees voting for were Lumsden, Hadcock, Scoville, Roberts, Hynes. The ballot being taken for Recorder C. W. Baldwin received five votes. Trustees voting for were Lumsden, Hadcock, Scoville, Roberts, Hynes. The Board then balloted for City Engineer. A. J. McLeune received five votes. Trustees Lumsden, Hadcock, Scoville, Hynes & Roberts voting for. H. B. Dayton then received five votes for Police Magistrate. Trustees Lumsden, Hadcock, Scoville, Hynes & Roberts voting for.

The Election of Town Attorney was laid over until next meeting on Motion of David Roberts.

On Motion of Mr Hadcock the matter of Brick Vault was laid over to next meeting. Bill of C. B. Hays for services as Marshal was laid over to next meeting.
