

Grand Junction April 21<sup>st</sup> 1888

A Special meeting of the Board, on call of the Mayor, was held for the purpose of contracting for water for the town for the season of 1888.

Upon joint request of F. B. Goudy Receiver of the Grand River Ditch Company and Geo A Crawford of the Pacific Slope Ditch Co who appeared before the Board for that purpose, it was moved seconded and carried; that the rental price for water for the season of 1888, be retained by the town and paid over to either of said parties only upon the written consent of the other, or in case said parties cannot agree as to whom it shall be paid the same shall be retained until the matter is determined in the courts.."

Motion made and carried that the Board hereby tender a vote of thanks to Hon F. B. Goudy Receiver of the Grand River Ditch Company for his action in turning on water for the town at the time of need.
