

Grand Junction May 18th 1888

Board met pursuant to adjournment. Present Mayor Lawrence
Trustees Haddock, Hynes, Lumsden, Scoville and Roberts.
The Ordinance entitled "an Ordinance to provide for a system
of water works for the town of Grand Junction, State of Colorado
for the extinguishment of fires, sanitary and other purposes,
granting to N J Knusen his associates, successors and assigns
the right to construct said water works, and contracting with
said N J Knusen his associates, successors and assigns
for the fire hydrants until said Town of Grand Junction
shall purchase said works and giving the said Town an
option to purchase said works."

On motion the yeas and nays were called for on the adoption
of Sec 4 of said Ordinance as read with the following
result. Haddock yea, Hynes yea, Lumsden yea, Scoville
yea, Roberts yea.

The Ordinance as a whole was then put upon its passage, and
yeas and nays called for with the following result.
Haddock yea, Hynes yea, Lumsden yea, Scoville yea
Roberts yea.

Board then adjourned.
