

Grand Junction June 15th 1888

Board met pursuant to adjournment. Present at Roll call Mayor Lawrence, Trustees Hadcock, Hynes, Scoville, Rea, Brunson. Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Petition of B. Bower to erect a one story frame building on lot 15 Block 125 was presented and filed.

The committee appointed at last meeting to inspect the Hotel Brunswick reported the same as in an unsafe condition, and to render the same fit for occupancy will require a new front and rear wall. Reports accepted and committee discharged.

The committee appointed at last meeting to see the owners of the property along Colorado Avenue in relation to repairing sidewalk were on motion allowed until next meeting to report. Also the committee on License were granted further time to make report.

On motion Morris Haggerty was allowed \$17.00 for lumber and nails for Bridge on 5th Street sidewalk.

Petition of Mrs. Rea claiming \$100 damages from overflow of city ditches to building on lot 25 in Block 58 was presented and ordered filed and a committee of 3 consisting of Hynes, Scoville and Brunson were appointed to examine the same, and report at next meeting.

Mr. J. H. McFarland on behalf of the Electric Light Co. appeared and asked an extension of time. on motion the matter was laid over to next meeting.

Motion made and carried that the Board proceed to elect a Town Attorney, Mr Staley being nominated a ballot was taken, and C A Staley receiving 5 votes for attorney was declared elected. Trustees voting were Lumsden, Rea, Scoville, Haddock & Hynes. A ballot was then taken for Town Printer.

Edwin Price received 5 votes for Town Printer and was declared elected. Trustees voting were Lumsden, Rea, Haddock, Hynes & Scoville

The Board then appointed the following persons as Judges of Election for the Special Election to be held on the 3rd day of July next: C A Staley, W H Rea, and Fred Halberon.

On motion the Recorder was instructed to procure a Ballot Box and Election blanks.

Board then adjourned.
