

Grand Junction June 8th 1888

Board met pursuant to adjournment. There were present at Roll call Mayor Lawrence, Trustees Hadcock, Gumsden, Hynes, Roberts and Saville.

The minutes of meeting of June 4th were read and approved. The following petition was then read and on motion ordered filed to the Honorable, The Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction:

The undersigned respectfully petition your honorable Board to call a Special Election at an early date for the purpose of submitting to the Electors of Grand Junction the question of granting to N J Kresew his associates and assigns a franchise to erect and construct water works to supply the town of Grand Junction and the inhabitants thereof with water for fire and domestic purposes - Said water to be taken from the Grand or Gunnison Rivers as the said Trustees deem best for the interests of said town.

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption of the following resolution with result as follows.
 Hadcock yea. Lumsden yea. Hynes yea. Roberts yea

Be it Resolved, That there shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the town of Grand Junction, in the County of Mesa and State of Colorado, at a special election, to be held on Tuesday, the 2nd of July A. D. 1888, at the council room in said town, for their approval or disapproval, the proposition for the Board of Trustees of said town to pass an ordinance authorizing N. J. Krusen, of Larned, Pawnee County, Kansas, his associates, successors and assigns, to establish, construct, operate and maintain a system of water works, for supplying the said town of Grand Junction and the inhabitants thereof with water, for domestic, sanitary and other uses and for the extinguishment of fires; the general plan of such works to be as follows: two pumps of 200,000 U. S. gallons each every twenty-four hours; an engine house built of either brick or stone, two boilers, and a stand pipe not less than 20 feet in diameter and 100 feet in height; four miles of pipe, wrought or cast iron pipe, varying in size from 10 to 4 inches, inside diameter; said works when completed to be capable of discharging four 1-inch streams from any four hydrants through fifty feet of 2 1/2-inch rubber hose and 1-inch nozzle to a height of 75 feet in any part of the town, and the supply of water for the same to be obtained from the Gunterson or Grand rivers, and to be of good quality and fit for domestic use, and in such ordinance agreeing, on the part of the town, to rent fifty hydrants and pay an annual rental of \$2,500.00 therefor. The ballots cast at said election upon the foregoing proposition shall contain the words "For the Krusen Water Works," or "Against the Krusen Water Works." And be it further
 Resolved, That the Town Recorder immediately post and cause to be published, a notice of the time and place of holding said election.

The committee appointed to investigate the Park reported that they had found fifteen dead trees, on motion report received and ordered filed.

Motion made and carried that a committee of three be appointed to confer with Mr A A Miller in regard to his delinquent license, and that said committee shall be authorized to accept five dollars license fee for each of the three ^{last} shows held in Mesa Opera Rink. Hadcock, Heynes and Roberts were appointed such committee.

On motion a Committee of three was appointed consisting of Heynes, Lumsden and Roberts to inspect the Brewswick Hotel and report its condition at next meeting.
