

Grand Junction June 4th 1888

Regular meeting of the Board of Trustees.

Present at Roll Call Mayor Lawrence, Trustees Hadcock Roberts, Scoville, Sumsden.

Minutes of the last regular meeting read and approved, also minutes of Special meetings of May 17th & 18th read and approved. On motion an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to provide for a system of water works for the town of Grand Junction State of Colorado for the extinguishment of fires sanitary and other purposes; granting to N J Krasue his associates successors and assigns the right to construct said water works and contracting with said N J Krasue his associates successors and assigns for the fire hydrants until said town of Grand Junction shall purchase said works and giving the said town an option to purchase said works." was put upon its passage the yeas and nays being called with the following result. Hadcock yea Scoville yea Roberts yea Sumsden yea.

Report of Treasurer for month of May presented and on motion accepted and ordered filed. Also report of Police Magistrate for month May received and filed.

The Finance Committee reported Bill of N J Quinn & Co for supplies \$4⁰⁰/₁₀₀ correct and on motion the same was allowed. Receipt for flume tax paid by Fletcher was presented and laid over, amt \$13

Bill of Edw Price for printing amt \$17⁰⁴/₁₀₀ was presented and on motion allowed.

On motion all Bills Not "O.K'd" were laid over.

Receipt for flume tax paid by G W Thurston amt \$6⁹⁰/₁₀₀ requesting refund of same was presented and referred to finance Committee. The matter of building sidewalk from the Rail Road Companys walk to 1st St and thence to Main St was on motion referred to Com on Streets Alleys and Bridges to report upon same at next meeting.

Motion made and carried that Mr Roberts be allowed to purchase lumber for a Bridge in the alley between Road & White St near fifth. Motion made and carried that Mr Carpenter be instructed to repair the sidewalk on 5th St between Main and Colorado Ave. On motion a Committee of three was appointed consisting of Hadcock Sumsden & Roberts to examine city Park and see if the trees are in proper condition.

On motion the Marshal was instructed to repair the Bridge at the Stock yards.

Motion made and carried that the Recorder draw warrants for Officers salaries for month May/88. Board then adjourned to Friday June 8th at 8 o'clock P.M.
