

Grand Junction Colo
July 2nd 1888

Regular meeting of the Board, Present at Roll call Mayor Lawrence, Trustees Rea, Roberts, Scoville, Hadcock and Lumsden.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Report of Town Treasurer for the month of June was received and referred to Finance Committee.

Committee on Sidewalks reported that M Devereux was ready to construct his part of it, 300 ft, also Mitchel was willing to construct his part. Report accepted & committee discharged.

The Committee appointed to examine Wm Rea's building and ascertain amount of damage to same by city water, reported the damage to be \$100.00. On motion the Committee was allowed further time to investigate and consult City Atty and report at next meeting.

The Committee on Licenses reported that they recommend the payment by A. L. Miller the sum of \$15.00 license fees amount due to date for theatrical performances. On motion report received and ordered that \$15.00 be received in full for same.

The following Bills which were referred to Finance Com at last meeting were taken up and allowed as follows,

The Grand Junction Electric Light Co petitioned for an extension of sixty days time in which to commence work, the yeas and nays being called for on same it was granted, those voting were Lumsden yea, Hadcock yea, Scoville yea, Roberts yea, Rea yea.

A petition for a water works Election to ^{prop} be owned by the Town was presented and on motion was received and read.

Wm Nishwitz appeared and asked an extension of 15 days time on license. On motion the matter was referred to the Licenses Com. On motion the Board proceeded to ballot for Recorder pro-tem. L. A. Staley received five votes. Trustees voting were Lumsden, Rea, Roberts, Scoville and Hadcock.

Whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed along the west side of Fifth St in front and along the side of lots 16 & 17 Block 118 in the Town of Grand Junction. Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as described by Ordinance save that it shall be 8 feet wide instead of 12 ft wide be constructed along said west side of said St. along and in front of said lots under the provisions of the ordinances concerning sidewalks.

also the following Resolution was adopted by the following vote
 Simonsden yea, Scoville yea Roberts yea. Rea yea Hadcock yea.

Whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees it is necessary to construct a new sidewalk beginning at the corner of 2nd and Pitkin streets, and along the East side of 2nd St. and in front and along the side of lots 1 & 2 Block 142, lots 1 & 2 Block 123, lots 1 & 2 Block 120 and in front of lots 1 to 16 inclusive Block 120 on the South side of Main Street Town of Grand Junction

Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as described by Ordinance except that it be 8 ft wide on 2nd St and 10 ft wide on Main St be constructed along said described lots under the provisions of the Ordinance concerning sidewalks.

Motion made and carried that a Special Marshal be appointed for the nights of July 3rd and 4th.

Board adjourned to July 7th 1888
