

Grand Junction Colo.
August 13th 1888.

The Board met pursuant to adjournment at 8 o'clock P.M. There were present at roll call, Mayor Sawma and Trustees Hadcock, Lunsden, Rea and Seville - Absent Trustees Hyman and Roberts. The minutes of the meeting of August 8th 1888, were read and approved.

A petition numerously signed, by the taxpayers & business men of the town was then presented, requesting the board to appropriate the sum of \$250⁰⁰ for the benefit of the Mesa County Fair Association. On motion the petition was ordered filed, and ordered that the Board donate from the general fund of the town to the Mesa County Fair Association the sum of \$250⁰⁰.

The Marshal reported to Board that it would cost from \$20⁰⁰ to \$25⁰⁰ to plow cotton wood park. And on motion the Marshal was instructed to have the same plowed.

It was then moved seconded and carried that the Mayor appoint a committee of three members of the Board to look over the ground and recommend the location of the water mains to be laid by Mr. Knauer. The Mayor appointed as such committee Trustees Rea, Seville and Roberts.

On motion the Mayor appointed Trustees Lunsden and Rea, to act in conjunction with himself as a committee to investigate as to whether a sidewalk should be laid along the west side of 2nd St. in front of lot 32 in Block 142, or whether such sidewalk should be laid on the opposite side of said street.

On motion the Board adjourned.
