

Grand Junction Oct 1st - 1888

Regular meeting of the Board at 8 o'clock Pm

There were present at roll call Mayor Lawrence, Trustees Hadcock, Hynes, Gumsden, Rea & Scoville. Absent Trustee Roberts

The minutes of last regular meeting of the Board were read and approved. Petition of Wm W Geowery, signed by the occupants of the lots within one-half Block of lot 1 Block 119, to conduct a retail liquor business on said lot, was received read and on motion the prayer of said petitioner was granted.

Report of Town Treasurer was received and on motion was accepted and ordered filed. also Report of Police Magistrate for month Sep was received and accepted and ordered filed.

Certificate of the street commissioner on the construction <sup>and cost</sup> of sidewalks in front of certain lots was presented read and approved, and on motion the Recorder was instructed to draw a warrant on the street fund to Dickie & Currie for \$504 <sup>1/100</sup> in payment of the construction of same.

The following Resolution was then offered. Resolved that a special tax of \$102.00 be and hereby is assessed against lot 1 in Block 123 and a special tax of \$45 <sup>1/100</sup> be and hereby is assessed against the south 50 feet of lot 32 Block 123

all in the Town of Grand Junction Mesa County Colorado, the said amounts respectively being the cost of constructing sidewalks along the sides and in front of said lots and parcels of ground respectively, said work of construction having been done in compliance with the order of this board and the ordinance in such case made and provided.

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of the foregoing Resolution with the following result. Gumsden yea. Hadcock yea. Scoville yea. Hynes yea. & Rea yea.

Motion made and carried that when the Board adjourns it adjourns to meet Oct 22nd - 1888 to hear and determine any and all complaints as to the justness of said sidewalk assessments.

On motion the Committee appointed to investigate the advisability of constructing a sidewalk to D M Jones residence was given further time in which to report.

Mr W A Reynch presented his resignation as City Marshal, which on motion was accepted.

A petition was received from B K Kennedy for appointment as City Marshal in place of W A Reynch resigned. petition read and ordered filed.

motion made and carried that the board proceed to ballot for billy  
marshal to fill vacancy caused by the resignation of W A Bynch,  
Ballot being taken B K Kennedy received five votes. Trustees voting  
were Sumner, Rea, Headcock, Hoines & Scoville.

motion made and carried that the night watchman W E Hascott be  
discharged from further duty after tonight and the Recorder instructed  
to draw a warrant in his favor for \$27 <sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> payment of services for  
eleven days.

A committee consisting of Scoville, Hoines & Headcock were appointed  
to have the Council Room fixed up and repaired.

The Recorder was instructed to draw warrants in payments of salaries  
of the several town officers.

Board then adjourned to October 22nd at 7 1/2 o'clock P M
