

Grand Junction Nov 23rd - 1885

Board met pursuant to adjournment.

Present at roll call Mayor Lawrence. Trustees Haddock, Leumsden
Rea, Roberts & Scoville. Absent Lewis.

Minutes of the meetings of Nov 9th and 16th were read and approved.

A petition for the construction of a four foot sidewalk along the east side
of Cottonwood Park (or Block 140 town of Grand Junction) was presented, read
& ordered filed.

On motion it was ordered by the Board that the construction of above
sidewalk & crossing be let to the lowest bidder - provided that the claim
for the work is not presented to the Board until there is money in the street
fund to pay for same.

On motion the Town Engineer was instructed to make a profile and
submit to the Board the grade of Main Street.

The following Ordinance was then introduced and read by the
Recorder. An ordinance entitled "an ordinance to authorize the creation,
construction and operation of a system of water works in the town of Grand
Junction for the extinguishment of fires, sanitary domestic and other purposes
granting to N J Krusen his associates successors and assigns the right
to construct and operate the same and contracting with said Krusen his
associates successors and assigns for fire hydrants;"

It was then moved and seconded that said named Ordinance be adopted
as a whole. Mr Staley the Town attorney then said "Before the vote is
taken, I desire and claim it my duty to again call the attention of the
Board to subdivision seventy-first of section 3312 of the General Statutes
of Colo of 1883: the plain intent of which is, if my construction be correct
that a town shall not pay to a water company as rental a greater
amount than can be raised by the levy of a three mill special tax.
The amount agreed to be paid by this ordinance far exceeds the amount
that can be so raised at the present time - or that can be so raised until
the value of the taxable property in the town shall have trebled what it now is.
For this reason I cannot recommend nor advise the adoption of either
section 3 or section 11 of this Ordinance as they now read."

The yeas and nays were then called upon said motion with the following
result. Trustees voting were Roberts yea, Rea yea, Leumsden yea, Scoville
yea, Haddock nay. Four Trustees having voted yea the Ordinance
as read was declared passed and adopted.

On motion the Board then adjourned to Wednesday Nov 28th at
7 $\frac{1}{2}$ PM
