

Grand Junction Dec 31st 1888

Board met at Council Rooms, ^{at 7³⁰ o'clock Pm} at the call of the Mayor for the purpose of locating the Fire Hydrants to be put in by the Water Company.

On motion the following Resolution was adopted.

"Resolved that it is the sense of the Board of Trustees that Water Hydrants for Fire purposes be and are hereby located on the following Street corners. To wit;
