

Grand Junction Jan 7th 1889

Regular meeting of the Board at the Council Rooms at 7³⁰ o'clock PM
Present at roll call Trustees Rea, Scoville, Hines, Hadcock, absent
Mayor Lawrence & Trustee Gunderen.

On the absence of Mayor Lawrence Trustee Roberts was elected mayor
pro-tem. The minutes of last regular and special meetings were
read and approved.

A petition for permit and license to conduct the business of retail liquor
dealer at the premises on lot 25 Blk 102, accompanied by the written
consent of property owners as required by ordinance, was presented by
A B Smalley. The yeas and nays were then called for on the motion to
grant said petition with following result. Trustees voting were Rea yea
Scoville yea. Hines yea Hadcock nay. motion carried & petition
granted.

A petition was presented by certain lot owners for construction of a
four foot sidewalk in front of lots 17 to 22 inclusive in Block 126.

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption of the following
resolution with following result. Trustees voting were Rea yea
Hadcock yea Hines yea. Scoville yea.

Whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees it is necessary that a new
sidewalk be constructed in front of lots 17 to 22 inclusive Block 126.

Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as provided by ordinance
save that it be four feet wide, be constructed in front of said lots under
the provisions of ordinances concerning sidewalks.

Report of Treasurer for month of Dec. 88 was presented, approved
& ordered filed. Report of Police Magistrate for month of Dec. 88
presented, approved & ordered filed.

Bond of N J Krusen as principal and W S Parks, Frank Parks
and H G Reeve as sureties as substitute for one filed Dec 7th was
presented and on motion approved. The yeas and nays being
called for on motion with following result Trustees voting were
Rea yea. Scoville yea. Hines yea. Hadcock yea.

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption of the
following resolution with result as follows. Trustees voting were
Rea yea Hines yea. Hadcock yea. Scoville yea. Resolution adopted
"Be it resolved and ordered. That the profile of sidewalk
grades on Main St between 1st and 7th Streets Grand Junction
Colorado as prepared and submitted to this Board by A J W. Cummings
Town Engineer dated December 21st 1888 be approved and
declared to be the official profile of the grades as therein
given in detail: And that the Recorder do endorse the approval
of this Board upon said profile and file the same in the office
of said Town Engineer.

An Ordinance, entitled An Ordinance Concerning Grades was then read by the Recorder and on motion the yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of said Ordinance with the following result. Trustees voting were Rea yea, Scoville yea, Heines yea, Hadcock yea. four trustees having voted yea the Ordinance was declared passed and adopted.

Mr J T Bailey and H D E Bong appeared before the Board and asked that the water mains be laid through certain streets so as to supply them with water. On motion a Committee of two was appointed to investigate the matter. Trustees Heines & Rea were appointed such Committee.

Motion made and carried that the Town Engineer be instructed to set grade stakes for sidewalks to be constructed hereafter.

Motion made by Trustee Heines that the Street Commissioner be instructed to purchase no more lumber and lay no more Street crossings after this date. except such purchase or work be ordered in writing signed by each and every member of the Committee on Streets and Alleys. Motion seconded and carried.
