

Grand Junction Jan 31st 1889

Special meeting of the Board at the call of the Mayor.

Present at roll call Mayor Lawrence Trustees Haddock, Gundersen Roberts, Pea and Seoville, absent Trustee Huies.

The Mayor stated that the meeting was called for the purpose of considering as to whether the pipe being put in by the Water Company is according to contract, and for the purpose of taking some action in the matter.

On motion the following Resolution was passed and adopted by the Board.

Resolved, That in the opinion of The Board the water mains and pipes now being distributed along the Streets of this town, are not of such a character as to comply with the requirements of the Ordinance granting a franchise to N J Krausen his associates successors and assigns, and that if he and his associates and assigns persist in furnishing and laying such character of mains and pipes, such work must be done at his own peril, and

Resolved, that the Recorder forthwith serve a copy of this Resolution upon said Krausen and his assigns.
