

Grand Junction Feb 4th 1889

Regular meeting of the Board at the Council Room at 7³⁰ o'clock P.M.
Present at Roll call Mayor Lawrence, Trustees Roberts, Rea
Rumsden, Scoville, Hadcock and Heines.

The minutes of the last regular meeting, and the special meeting
of Jan 31 st read and approved.

Report of Treas for month of Jan read and approved
and Report of Police Magistrate for month Jan read and approved

Petition of Mrs L W Steele to erect a frame store building on the
south part of lot 22 Block 118 was presented and on motion prayer
of petitioner was granted.

Petition of Jas McCreavy et al for construction of sidewalks
on east side of 3rd St from Main St to Catholic Church was presented
and on motion referred to Committee on Streets and Alleys.

Petition of Avis Clark and others for sidewalk on north side of Good
Street from 5th to 6th Street was presented and on motion referred
to Committee on Streets and Alleys.

Motion made that the Bond filed by Kruseu, Park and Reeves Jan 7
1889 be accepted and approved in lieu of the Bond of Kruseu.

McFarland, Canon and Miller filed Dec 3rd 1888 and the Recorder
instructed to deliver said Bond of Dec 3rd to the sureties therein
named. The yeas and nays were called for on above motion
with following result. Trustees voting were Roberts yea, Rea yea
Scoville yea, Hadcock yea, Heines yea Rumsden yea.

Bill of Kent and Campbell for lumber nails &c #13,12 was presented
and on motion referred to finance committee.

Also Bill of Grand Junction Telephone and Electric Light Co #121,15
was on motion referred to same Committee.

a motion was made and carried that the Mayor appoint
a committee of six citizens of Grand Junction to meet on
Thursday Feb 7th for the purpose of investigating said
charges. The Mayor then appointed as such Com
Benton Canon, H J Quinn, O B Crawford, W J Connelly
O M Jones & H Heines.

Board then adjourned to Feb 11th at 7³⁰ o'clock
