On motion the reading of the minutes was dispensed with

A petition signed by Marsh, Adams & others, praying
that the Board take some steps to prevent the Water Company
from putting in the pipe scattered through the Streets, was
presented read and on motion ordered filed.

Mr Reeves of the Water Co being present made a statement in
regard to the pipe which they intend putting in called "Phipps
Hydraulic Pipe" and also furnished the Board with
several references of Companies who are using the same,
and the Recorder was instructed to correspond with those
parties in relation thereto.
