

Grand Junction Colo  
Mch 11th 1889

Board met pursuant to adjournment, at 7<sup>30</sup> o'clock P M  
Present at Roll call Mayor Lawrence, Trustees Heines  
Haddock, Remusden, Scoville, Rea absent Trustee Roberts

Minutes of last meeting read and approved  
Report of Committee on Streets and Alleys recommended that  
a sidewalk be constructed as per petition on East side of 3rd  
St from Main St to corner of Block 80 on White St,  
Signed J J Remusden, H H Rea

and J H Haddock Com

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption  
of the following resolution with the following result.  
Trustees voting were Rea yea, Haddock yea, Heines yea,  
Scoville yea, Remusden yea.

"Whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees it is necessary  
that a new sidewalk be constructed on the East side of 3rd St  
along the West side of lots 32 and 1 in Block 102 and along  
the West side of lots 32 and 1 in Block 97.  
Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as provided by  
Ordinance save that it be four feet wide, be constructed along  
the West side of said lots under the provisions of Ordinances  
concerning sidewalks."

The Finance Committee reported an Appropriation Bill and  
recommended the following appropriations for next fiscal year,  
For Police fund \$1500. Streets and Alleys fund \$3000,  
For Water fund \$400. For Street lighting fund \$950.  
For Rental Fire Hydrants \$1150. For Fire Dept \$1500.  
For Seal fund \$2000. Report adopted.

An Ordinance entitled "The Annual Appropriation Bill" for  
the fiscal year beginning April 1st 1889 and ending Mch 31st 1890  
was then read, the yeas and nays being called for on its  
adoption with the following result. Trustees voting were  
Rea yea, Remusden yea, Scoville yea, Heines yea, Haddock yea  
The Ordinance was then declared passed and adopted.

The Certificate of the Street Commissioner on the construction  
and cost of sidewalks in front of certain lots was presented  
read and approved, and on motion the Recorder was instructed  
to draw a warrant on the Street fund in favor of Dickie & Currie  
for \$105 <sup>40</sup>/<sub>100</sub> in payment of construction of same.

Motion made and carried that the Street Committee be  
instructed the Marshal to put down Street and Alley crossings  
where they are required to connect sidewalks already  
constructed. Motion made and carried that a committee of  
two be appointed to procure water for the town for irrigation.  
Trustees Scoville and Heines were appointed such Committee.

Board then adjourned to next regular meeting
