Wednesday April 3rd 1889

Board met pursuant to adjournment at 7³⁰ o'clock P.M.
Present at roll call Mayor Lawrence Trustees Heines
Haddock, Dunsden, Rea and Roberts.

Minutes of meeting of March 11th 1889 and last regular
meeting of April 1st were read and approved.

Report of Town Treasurer for month of March received
read and referred to incoming Council, also the annual
Report of Town Treas was received and referred to incoming
Council. Report of Police Magistrate read and referred
to incoming Council.

The Annual Report of Recorder was presented read
and on motion accepted and ordered filed.

Petition of H. F. Barnard et al for construction of a
sidewalk in front of lots 17 to 32 Block 118 was presented
read and on motion laid over.

Motion made and carried that A. A. Miller be remitted
Ten Dollars License fee.

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption of the
following resolution with the following result. Trustees
voting were Rea yea Heines yea, Dunsden yea Haddock
yea Doolittle yea, resolution declared adopted.
