

Grand Junction 26th April 5th
1889

Board met pursuant to adjournment at 7³⁰ o'clock PM

Present at roll call Mayor Rhone Trustees Bliss Adams
Pardue Kent, Crosby, Sharp.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Petition of H F Barnard and others for construction of
a sidewalk on north side of Colo Av between 4th and 5th
St was presented and on motion referred to the Committee on
Streets and Alleys.

The Committee appointed to make the tender of \$2000 to
the Ditch Co for water reported that they had been unable
to find the Supt. On motion the Committee was discharged

The monthly and Annual Reports of the Treasurer which were
laid over April 1st were referred to the Com on Finance

Also the Report of Police Magistrate was laid over
till next meeting.

Motion made and carried that all applications for
appointment to office be laid over to next meeting

Motion made and carried that the Board take up the Water question.

Mr Caswell then offered the following proposition in writing. "To the Hon Mayor and Board of Trustees Grand Junction Cal. I hereby propose to furnish to said town of Grand Junction for irrigation of trees Streets and lawn 100 statute inches of water from the Grand River Ditch for the season of 1889 and until Dec 1 next for the sum of \$29000 in Town Warrants or to furnish 100 inches of water for the season of 1889, 1890 and 1891 for \$300 per season Water to be furnished at Ditch known as Grand River Ditch, and such to be paid each season in advance in town Warrants. Dated at Grand Junction Cal Apl 8, 1889

Motion made and carried that the discussion of the water question be confined to the members of the Council

Motion made and seconded that Mr Caswells proposition to furnish water for 1 year season 1889 be accepted,

Yeas and Nays called for on foregoing motion with following result. Trustees voting were Bliss yea Adams yea Pardue nay Kent nay Brosby yea Sharp nay. The vote standing 3 yeas and 3 nays Mayor Rhone voted nay and motion lost.

Motion made and carried that the applications for office be taken from the table and passed upon.

The Board proceeded to ballot for Mayor pro tem. J F Sharp received five votes Trustees voting for were Bliss Adams, Kent, Brosby, Pardue. J F Sharp declared elected mayor pro tem.

Ballot then taken for Town Treasurer W J Quinn received six votes. Trustees voting for were Bliss, Pardue, Adams Kent, Sharp, Brosby. W J Quinn declared elected Treas

Ballot was then taken for Recorder C W Baldwin received six votes Trustees voting for were Bliss, Pardue, Adams Sharp, Kent, Brosby.

Ballot was then taken for Town Marshal B K Kennedy received five votes. Trustees voting for were Bliss Brosby, Kent, Adams, Sharp, and Jos Hemitt received one vote. Trustees voting for were Pardue.

B K Kennedy was declared elected marshal.

Ballot then taken for Police Magistrate. H B Boyton received six votes. Trustees voting for were Bliss, Adams Pardue, Kent, Sharp, Brosby.

Ballot then taken for Town Attorney. Henry R Rhone received five votes Trustees voting for were Bliss Adams, Pardue, Kent, Sharp, and C A Staley received one vote. Trustees voting for were Brosby Henry R Rhone declared elected atty

Ballet then taken for Town Engineer. A J McName received six votes. Trustees voting for were Bliss Pardue Adams Kent, Sharp, Brosley.
