Motion made and carried that the Recorder call the attention of the Water des to See 8 of an Ordinance granting franchise to n & Krusen et al, also that they replace under the direction of the town Engineer, all grade monuments that have been removed by digging trenches for water pipe. On motion the Recorder was unstructed to correspond with The Denver and Rio Grande Ry Co in regard to the removal of the Stock yards from the limits of out Street. Motion made and carried that the marshal procure proper blanks and scrue them upon for party owners to clean up The alleys and water closets. motion made and carried that the town attorney draft an Ordinance fixing the defoth of Vaults at 8 feet. motion made and carried That the Street Commissioner be Sworn in and the Mayor approve his Bond. motion made and carried that the force of labor be \$21,215 per day in Joan Harrants and that the St Commissioner suplay tat payers if fossible.
