

Grand Junction Colo April 9th 1889

Board met pursuant to adjournment at 7³⁰ o'clock PM

Present at roll call Mayor Rhone Trustees Bliss, Adams
Pardue, Crosby, Kent, Sharp.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

On motion the Annual Report of the Police Magistrate was
accepted.

The Committee appointed at last meeting to locate a
route for a lateral from the Grand River Canal to the town
site reported that the most practicable route to be along
the line of beauty Road, and on West side of land owned
by T B Crawford and Amos Strode, and advised the
location of same on said route. Report signed by Com
Adams and Pardue. On motion report accepted
and Committee discharged.

Report of Committee on Streets and Alleys on Petition for
construction of sidewalk on North side of Colorado Avenue
between 4th and 5th was presented. Report recommended
construction of same.

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption of the following resolution with the following result.

Trustees voting were Adams yea. Bliss yea Brosby yea Kent yea. Sharp yea.

" Whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed along and in front of lots 17 to 32 inclusive in Block 118. Therefore he it ordered that a sidewalk such as provided by ordinance except it be four feet wide be constructed in front of said lots under the provisions of Ordinances concerning sidewalks.

On motion the Board proceeded to Ballot for Town Printer Ballot being taken Edwin Price received 5 votes. Trustees voting for were Adams, Bliss, Brosby, Kent, Sharp, Pardue Bliss not voting.

Ballot then taken for Street Commissioner J A Hunt received four votes Trustees voting for were Bliss, Brosby, Pardue Adams and the Mayor, and Felix Touffain received three votes Trustees voting for were Kent, Sharp, Bliss Jos A Hunt was declared elected St Commissioner.

Motion made and carried that the Recorder call the attention of the Water-Geo to Sec 8 of an Ordinance granting franchise to N J Krusen et al, also that they replace under the direction of the town Engineer, all grade monuments that have been removed by digging trenches for water pipe.

On motion the Recorder was instructed to correspond with The Denver and Rio Grande Ry Co in regard to the removal of the Stock Yards from the limits of 6th Street.

Motion made and carried that the Marshal procure proper blanks and serve them upon property owners to clean up the Alleys and water closets.

Motion made and carried that the town Attorney draft an Ordinance fixing the depth of Vaults at 8 feet.

Motion made and carried that the Street Commissioner be sworn in and the Mayor approve his bond.

Motion made and carried that the price of labor be \$2.25 per day in Town Warrants and that the St Commissioner employ tax payers if possible.

On Motion the Board adjourned to Monday April 22nd at 7³⁰ o'clock PM
