

Grand Junction Colo April 19<sup>th</sup> 89

Special meeting of Board for the purpose of considering the water question.

Present at roll call Mayor Rhone, Trustees Adams Bliss, Brosby, Pardue, Kent and Sharp,

Motion made by Trustee Bliss that the town reimburse the citizens who have guaranteed to G. F. Caswell Reese two hundred and ninety dollars for 100 inches of water for the season of 1889. Yeas and Nays were called for on the above motion with the following result. Trustees voting were Adams yea Bliss yea Brosby yea Pardue yea Sharp yea Trustee Kent not voting for the reason that he could not vote to pay an amount exceeding the rate fixed by the Board of County Commissioners.

Motion made by Trustee Adams that the Recorder is instructed to draw a Warrant on the Treas for the sum of \$290.00 in payment of said 100 inches of water for the year 1889, and that the town Attorney make a contract with the proper persons for the same,

The yeas and nays were called for on the foregoing motion with the following result. Trustees voting were Adams yea Bliss yea Brosby yea, Pardue yea. Sharp yea. Trustee Kent not voting.
