

Grand Junction Colo May 6th
1889

Regular meeting of the Board. Present at roll call
Mayor Rhone, Trustees Adams, Bliss, Crosby, Purdue
Sharp, absent Trustee Kent.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved,
Report of Treasurer for month of April read and on motion
referred to Finance Committee.

Report of Police Magistrate read and on motion approved,
The Committee appointed at last meeting to confer with Trustee
Kent and request him to reconsider his Resignation reported
that he declined to reconsider, on motion committee discharged
motion made and carried that the Resignation of Trustee Kent
be accepted.

The Finance Committee reported that they had examined The
Books of the Treasurer and found them correct.

Petition by R D Medley and others for the removal of the
slaughter pens of Stephen Scoville was presented read and
on motion of Mr Bliss the prayer of petitioners was granted
and removal ordered ^{to be made} within thirty days.

Bill of Edwin Price for printing presented and on motion referred
to Finance Committee.

Motion made and carried that the former contract with Mr Kennedy be annulled, and the Recorder is instructed to advertise for bids to perform all team work required upon the Streets,

An Ordinance to amend article 1 of Chapter VI of the Revised Ordinances of the town of Grand Junction, was then read and the yeas and nays called for on its adoption with the following result. Trustees voting were Adams yea Bliss yea. Crosby yea. Pardue yea. Sharp yea. the Ordinance as read declared passed and adopted.

On motion of Mr Adams a Committee of two was appointed to attend to the removal of the Town pound from its present location. Trustees Adams and Pardue were appointed such committee.

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of the following resolution with the following result Trustees voting were Adams yea Bliss yea. Crosby yea Pardue yea Sharp yea.

"Be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the town of Grand Junction that the action now pending in the Circuit Court of the United States for the District of Colorado between the Mayor of the Town of Grand Junction Plaintiff and William Keith Defendant and heretofore prosecuted in the name of William B Lawrence Mayor of the Town of Grand Junction and entitled " W B Lawrence as Mayor of the town of Grand Junction in Mesa County Colorado and trustee for the use and benefit of the occupants of the town site of Grand Junction Plaintiff

William Keith Defendant

commenced on the 8th day of June 1888 be dismissed and the Town Attorney is hereby authorized to appear in said cause for the purpose of dismissing said cause.

It appearing to the Board that no further necessity existed for the continuance of the office of Commissioner for the town of Grand Junction for the purpose of signing acknowledging and executing Deeds for said town, it was on motion declared vacant, and Thomas B Crawford heretofore appointed such Commissioner is removed from said office.

On motion the Board then adjourned to Thursday May 9th at 7³⁰ o'clock PM
